



# **Application & Enrollment Guidelines**

## **First Step: Inquiry process**

Call the school to request information or look online at [www.holdenhigh.org](http://www.holdenhigh.org)

Make an appointment to tour the school or

Attend an Information Night (August 5<sup>th</sup>, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, October 28<sup>th</sup>,  
January 6<sup>th</sup>, May 26<sup>th</sup>: from 6-8)

## **Second Step: Application process**

Complete and return Application Form

Enclose application fee of \$50

Send in additional documents: transcripts or most recent report card, current IEP or 504 plan, learning assessment, and a release (if applicable)

Submit a writing sample (essay, research paper, creative writing piece)

Schedule student for a visit day

Student interview will be held at the end of the visit day or tour

Optional: schedule student for a visit week. The non-refundable fee for a visit week is \$250

For rolling admissions, please allow 3 to 4 weeks for decision to be mailed once all paperwork is submitted

## **Third Step: Enrollment**

Schedule a contract meeting. Your first monthly payment is due at this meeting.

Trial Month begins. Each contract has a one-month cancellation clause to protect you if, for any reason, your family is not satisfied and/or the school cannot adequately serve the student.

## **Tuition:**

**Tuition is \$23,850 per year.**

## **Financial Aid:**

**Holden is committed to economic diversity. A generous and flexible financial aid program and funded scholarships make it possible for Holden High School to admit talented, motivated students from across the economic spectrum.** Please request a financial aid application from our Admissions office.

We cannot give you a specific tuition quote until we have processed your financial aid application and supporting tax documents. Tuition may be paid in one or two payments, or in monthly increments. Monthly payments include a one time \$100 administrative charge.

Tuition includes free individual weekly counseling for students and four family counseling meetings, all books, materials, and supplies. Tuition does not cover additional tutoring (if requested), field trips or yearbooks.
